

We are kicking off the new year with a month's worth of horror

features from various eras starting off with two Universal 1930s films that demonstrate so well the atmosphere the studio was known for in that era. First, it's the rarely-seen shocker The Invisible Ray — in which Karloff has discovered a healing ray... that can also bring death! Bela Lugosi costars as the doctor who is his adversary — and could be his victim! We follow that up with our second '30s entry — one that we have had many requests for since we first ran it on our show last year - 1932's The Old Dark House. Karloff is a menacing mute butler in an old decrepit mansion owned by some odd unstable characters naturally, the perfect place for unsuspecting guests to be stranded! The amazing cast includes Charles Laughton, Gloria Stuart, and Ernest Thesiger, in a mix of thrills with a dash of comedy.

Then, we jump to the 1960s for a chapter in Britain's Hammer Studio's Frankenstein series — with Peter Cushing as Dr. Frankenstein, still being pursued for his ungodly experiments, returning to his home town, finding his home has been looted by the local corrupt authorities, and locating his missing creation for use in getting back at his enemies! We round out January with some 1970s horror: the original Willard — starring Bruce Davison as the title character, who is constantly put upon by his nagging mother and her friends, and his shifty boss, who stole the company from his father. He's no Dr. Dolittle, but he learns to talk to the animals - specifically, rats and uses them as his instrument of revenge. Ernest Borgnine, Elsa Lanchester, and Sondra Locke are among the humans in the cast. So, this month goes from radiation all

the way to infestation — with humans, non-humans and subhumans.


