






#### Zoom 07/27/2024

This month, we aimed for a real variety of fright films, with some of our favorite horror stars, special effects, and unusual plots. We begin with 1955's Cult of the Cobra — with a woman with transformative powers who is out to get revenge on the unwitting interlopers who witnessed the secret ritual of a serpentworshipping sect. Faith Domergue is the vengeful viper vixen, and among those she is targeting are many familiar TV actors — including David Janssen and Richard Long. Then, we move on to one of our favorite horror stars, the one and only Vincent Price — as a skilled magician, master of disguise and creator of stage-magic effects who is cheated out of presenting one of his greatest illusions by a scheming business partner (didn't he have the same problem in House of Wax?) When it looks like his new trick will be claimed by a competing

magician, Gallico the Great (Vincent) is driven to madness and murder in The Mad Magician — a 1954 film that was once presented in 3-D, and includes in its cast Eva "Green Acres" Gabor.

Next up — it's some of the great stop-action animation of the genre's master Ray Harryhausen when a nuclear submarine encounters some unknown thing that proves to be a huge octopus, driven from its deep oceanic abode by a hydrogen bomb. San Francisco becomes the target of this creature — in Harryhausen's 1955 It Came from Beneath the Sea. We follow that up with a unique horror from 1940 — with Boris Karloff and featuring Bela Lugosi in a very different role for him — that of a gangster! In this film, Karloff is a doctor who endeavors to save the life of his friend — a mild mannered college professor — by implanting another man's brain into his body. The only problem is that man was a criminal — and the recovering professor begins to transform into the thug, with his sights set on his former gangster rivals (including Lugosi) — and out to regain a fortune in stolen money! It's Black Friday featuring Stanley Ridges as the brain transplant recipient. We wind up August with a 1958 product of the prolific Bert I. Gordon — well known for presenting movie menaces that can be described by his initials —BIG! This one was a follow-up to his Amazing Colossal Man — in which the towering terror, thought to be dead, is discovered south of the border, disfigured and suffering from brain injuries that have left him a savage monster — who, naturally, ends up migrating back to the United States to create havoc. So, our August

offerings come in all sizes and shapes — to add some scary sizzle to our summer schedule!
