Zoom 09/14/2024



Svengoolie

No doubt you noticed the "House of Svengoolie" listings for a couple of our second features — its films being hosted by our Sven Squad: Gwengoolie, IMP, and Nostalgiaferatoo! This is made even more special by the fact that they are presenting two films that came from the genius of "Muppets" creator Jim Henson. We'll tell you more — but let's go through our complete schedule; starting off with a Universal classic Son of Frankenstein — the third film in the "Frankenstein" series, and the last to feature Boris Karloff as the Monster. It also brought us our first look at the deranged hunchbacked blacksmith Igor, played by Bela Lugosi. Basil Rathbone is heir to the Frankenstein legacy, and returns home to claim it — only to be less than welcomed by the villagers who suffered through the Monster's reign of terror. Things only get worse when it is revealed that the Monster still lives! We follow that

with Monster That Challenged the World — a 1950s chiller in which giant prehistoric mollusks escape from a crevasse created by an undersea earthquake!

The next week has our annual showing of one of our most requested movies — the hilarious haunted house epic starring Don Knotts — The Ghost and Mr. Chicken! Stay tuned after that for one of my personal favorites -Fiend Without a Face — in which invisible killer brains, powered by atomic energy, cause a rampage of death — and are even more incredible when they become visible! Their stop-motion animation form remains as a favorite of mine! Week three of our October schedule has another favorite from the 50s — the Vincent Price horror classic that was originally presented in 3-D — House of Wax (we actually hoped to show it in 3-D but — too many complications)!

Then, we premiere the "House of Svengoolie" — with our three Sven Squad friends given the chance to do their own thing, presenting Labyrinth — a fantasy film directed by the great Jim Henson, written by Monty Python's Terry Jones, and executive produced by George Lucas! Starring Jennifer Connelly and David Bowie — and featuring many Henson puppet characters is the story of a young woman entering a strange labyrinth to rescue her baby brother from the Goblin King. The final Saturday of October holds two tricky treats for you — first, we have finally gotten the sought-after original version of Invaders from Mars! This 1953 sci-fi classic, the story of a young boy who sees a flying saucer and subsequently finds his parents and

others around him under the control of alien forces — with a tremendous conclusion as David tries to escape the bizarre Martian creatures! Then, as the last part of our double features, it's another "House of Svengoolie" — with another Jim Henson film! The Sven Squad brings us Dark Crystal another fantasy film directed by Henson and "Muppets" partner Frank Oz in which two elf-like beings must try to restore order to their world by restoring a powerful broken crystal. Plenty of fantastic creatures abound — and bring a fantastic ending to this year's month of double features!
